## NM63/18 Motion Pursuant to Notice - Notice of Motion from Cr Said - Opposition to Passenger Cruise Ship Terminal (F2014/00125)

247/18 **RESOLUTION: (Said/Da Rocha)** that Randwick Council strongly opposes a passenger cruise ship terminal and takes the following actions:

- write to the NSW Government stating Council's strong opposition to a proposed passenger cruise-ship terminal at either Yarra Bay or Molineux Point noting Council's strong concerns about the negative impact a passenger terminal would have on the area including traffic congestion, environmental destruction, loss of open green space and flow-on land-use pressures;
- 2. request an urgent meeting with the relevant NSW and Federal Ministers asking for further investigation of alternate sites;
- 3. prepare an application to list Yarra Bay Beach and Frenchman's Beach as state heritage items;
- 4. re-affirm its current commitment to these areas as having local heritage significance; and
- 5. prepare a report outlining potential studies into the environmental significance of impacted areas and potential risks of a major change to land-use in the area.
